### **ASU to hold meeting over EBA dispute at Glen Eira Council**

The Australian Services Union will be holding a meeting of members today to vote on Glen Eira Council's Enterprise Bargaining Agreement offer. The meeting will decide whether or not members want to accept the offer handed down by Council, and dependent on which way members vote, an action may be held straight after the meeting.

"Glen Eira's offers to date have been low," said ASU Organiser Lita Gillies.

"The current offer of 3.5% (or a flat rate of \$38.00 in 2010), 3.6% (or a flat rate of \$36.00 in 2011), and 3.6% (or a flat rate of \$37.00 in 2012) is low when considering that Council's pay rates are on the lower end of the scale when compared to other Councils in this area."

"At this stage, it will be surprising if members don't take to the streets after the meeting. All Glen Eira City Council workers want is a fair days pay for a fair days work. Glen Eira employees work extremely hard to offer ratepayers the very best service they can, and it's time for Council to put their hands in their pocket and show that they appreciate all the hard work their employees do. Glen Eira City Council workers aren't monkeys - they need more than peanuts to survive," said Gillies.
