ASU members at Maribyrnong City Council ready for industrial action as EBA negotiations stall

Australian Services Union members at Maribyrnong City Council will be prepared to take protected industrial action after negotiations surrounding their Enterprise Bargaining Agreement stalled, according to ASU Organiser Dean Dando.

ASU members overwhelmingly rejected the council's offer of a 12 per cent wage increase over the next three years, voting against the submission at a meeting at Maribyrnong City Council last Thursday.

"Our members have called on the ASU and its delegates to call an urgent meeting with the acting CEO Vince Haining to pursue a better outcome for wages and to receive some further discussion on an End of Band payment clause."

"ASU members have made it quite clear that they are prepared to have their union seek protected industrial action through the Fair Work Australia legislation if a better outcome is not reached," said Dando.
